Render Free is a 100% Black woman-owned communal wellness club for Black and Brown women. Named after a pursuit to “make liberation”, Render Free’s purpose is to provide a safe space to belong, away from the predominantly white environments many women of color must navigate. One founding member expresses, “Render Free is a space for me. It allows me to be my entire self - I not only feel welcomed I feel celebrated! It has been a wonderful resource for my mental health.” This new community resource offers a hybrid membership, community lounge, cafe, and co-working area for its members to gather, belong and heal.

Arielle Grant, the founder of Render Free, sought out a place to protect her from the battery of racial trauma. She found peace at Black-owned shops and restaurants, realizing that every Black and Brown woman needed a communal space to remind her of her worth amidst a world where it's called into question. “I hope to cultivate and bear witness to a community of Black and Brown women who are practicing the prioritization of their own wellbeing,” says Grant.
